SMALL TALK

1. Share a moment when you felt particularly connected to a sense of something greater than yourself, whether through nature, relationships, or a spiritual experience. How did that moment impact your beliefs or worldview?

VIEWPOINT

2. **READ Genesis 1:1.** What implications does this founding declaration have for our worldview?
3. **READ Romans 1:18-20.** How does this passage suggest that evidence of God's existence can be found in the natural world? What does this say about some hidden reasons why people may refuse to see the natural world as evidence for God's existence?
4. **READ Hebrews 11:6.** Why is faith essential in pleasing God? What can a person do who has doubts? Can they still earnestly seek God? Compare this with Jesus' words (see Matthew 7:7-8)

GETTING PERSONAL

5. Take a moment to evaluate your own faith journey. In what areas of your life do you struggle to trust God or step out in faith? How can Hebrews 11:6 encourage you to strengthen your belief and trust in God?

MAKING PROGRESS (THIS WEEK)

6. Take a nature walk or spend time outdoors intentionally observing the beauty and intricacy of God's creation. As you observe, reflect on how the natural world reflects the glory and presence of God. Verbalize these reflections as praise and thanks to God.
