- **<u>Unsinkable</u>**. That was the word used to describe the RMS Titanic.
- April 15th, 1912 (112 years ago tomorrow); 1,500 people +
- Unsinkable..



- When was a time that you were confident in something and it failed you? (or someone)
 - Job..relationship..finances..promotion
- God's Word won't fail us! It won't sink.
- The fear is that what if it hits an iceberg..what if someone points out a contradiction, or what about other books, were additions made to it, on and on it goes. Can we trust it?

Why Can I Trust the Bible?

2 Timothy 3:15-16

Based on multiple layers of evidence, we can trust that the Bible is God's Word to us.

What the Bible Says About Itself (2 Tim. 3:16-17)

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, **17** so that the servant of $God_{\lfloor \alpha \rfloor}$ may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

- -2 Timothy 3:16-17
- God breathed
- Useful!
- Why? to be thoroughly equipped for every good work
- Swiss army knife: When I was a kid, I found a swiss army knife on a camping trip

• Single mom with your kids? That co-worker? Serve here Sundays?

2. What Jesus Says About It (Luke 4)

Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone.'" (vs. 4)

Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.'" (vs. 8)

For it is written,

"'He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,'

and

"'On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone."" (vs. 10-11)

And Jesus answered him, "It is said, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test." (vs. 12)

- What's your go-to in temptation? (what are you reaching for?)
 - Are you *medicating* or are you *meditating*? (on your word I meditate day and night)
 - One brings temporary relief the other brings lasting peace
 - The icebergs of life do not stop! God's Word is reliable. Those other things, will give out (like the Titanic's failure of the rivets used to fasten the hull plates to the ship's main structure).



For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope. -Romans 15:4


