- 2. **READ Colossians 2:6-23.** How did Paul tell the Colossians to continue in Christ? (2:6-7) What false teaching was threatening this approach? (2:8, 11-12, 16-17, 20-23)
- 3. What did God already give believers? (2:10) How does this demonstrate that we need no religious ritual "shadows" (2:17) as "add-ons" to the "substance" (2:17) we enjoy? What are the "shadows" the false teachers were insisting on?
- 4. Why do such humanly conceived additions appeal to many (vv. 18–19, 22–23)? Why are legalism and asceticism useless in making us spiritually mature or more complete in Christ (vv. 22–23)?
