

SMALL TALK

1. When have you felt empty, depleted, and lacking whatever it was that you needed? What brought this about?

VIEWPOINT

- 2. **READ Colossians 1:15-20.** What is clear in this passage is that Jesus is completely supreme, and sufficient. Which phrases grab your attention?
- 3. Colossians 1:15-20 is written in classic Hebrew poetic form, and may have been sung as a hymn. Where did its theology of the deity of Christ come from? (Numbers 12:8; Hebrews 11:27; Daniel 7:13-14; Matthew 27:63-64; Ezekiel 1:26-28; John 1:18; 14:9; 15:24; 1 Cor. 4:4-6; Psalm 89:24; John 1:14; 3:16; 8:19, 23, 28, 38, 58; 1 Cor. 8:6)

GETTING PERSONAL

- 4. What difference does an accurate understanding of Jesus make for a person who is feeling "empty", or "broken"?
- 5. Why is worshipping the one who is deserving of all glory, honor, and power important and helpful? (Ephesians 1:21; Revelation 5:1-14) Why is worshipping together with his congregation commanded? (see Colossians 3:16)
