SMALL TALK

- **READ Psalm 34**. This psalm has 2 parts. Where do you think the dividing line is? What subtitle would you give the first half? The rest?
- Why is "praise" always to be on our lips? (34:1) Why is praising God "together" important? (34:3)?
- How could David "taste and see" that the Lord is good? (34:8) Is he saying that the "righteous" will never die of hunger? (34:10)

- What do you think it means to "take refuge" in God? (34:8, and 34:22)
